HERE ARE SOME BASIC TIPS:



**HAVE A
CONVERSATION
WITH YOUR
CHILDREN, NOT
A LECTURE.**

A conversation because you're going to speak and allow them to speak too, hear their opinions, know their previous knowledge, tell them about dangerous websites and malwares.



**DON'T ALLOW THEM
USE THE
COMPUTER IN
SECRECY.**

Keep the computer/tablet/phone to be used for e-learning in a common area of the house where everybody can access so that you can see them and know what they're up to.




**NO GADGETS

Do not allow children to use computers overnight or take it in when going to bed. All computers and phones should be left in a central location or locked away safely in the lobby.




**SWITCH OFF WIFI

PREVIOUS CONVERSATION.**




**KNOW YOUR CHILDREN'S

**USE A FILTER TO BLOCK
PORNOGRAPHIC, ADULT RATED
OR VIOLENT SITES. ENSURE
THAT THE ANTIVIRUS INSTALLED
ON THE COMPUTER IS UPDATED.**



**WATCH OUT FOR CHANGES IN
YOUR CHILD'S BEHAVIOR,
SPEAK TO A COUNSELOR OR
PSYCHOLOGIST AS SOON AS
YOU OBSERVE ANYTHING OF
CONCERN.**


